ORDINANCE NO. **12855**

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the executive to negotiate a direct sale of a Century camera stand to the Museum of History and Industry.

STATEMENTS OF FACT:

1. The King County Department of Public Safety owns a Century camera stand that is no longer used.
2. The camera stand was used to take mug photos from 1910 to 1974 and is of notable historic value.
3. The Museum of History and Industry is a private, non-profit corporation whose mission is to collect, preserve and exhibit artifacts and archival material significant to the history of Seattle and King County.
4. The Museum of History and Industry has expressed an interest in adding the camera stand to their collection.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Unique circumstances make a negotiated direct sale in the best interests of the public. The King County Executive is authorized to negotiate a direct sale
