ORDINANCE NO. 12866

AN ORDINANCE establishing a fiscal policy for the Development and Environmental Services Fund, allowing annual expenditure and FTE authority increases no greater than 15% in excess of expected fee receipts, based on actual volume of activity and receipts, for the sole purpose of processing permits.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby established a policy allowing annual expenditure authority increases of not more than 15% in excess of expected fee receipts, based upon actual volume of activity and receipts for the sole purpose of processing permits for the development and environmental service fund.

SECTION 2. There shall be established a permit processing contingency account in the annual budget of the department of development and environmental services in an amount equal to 15% of expected annual fee receipts for the purpose of responding to unanticipated increases in permit activity. The corresponding FTE authority shall also be budgeted in the contingency.

SECTION 3. The annual budget should provide that if the number of applications and/or receipts from new applications exceed the amount assumed in the adopted financial plan in any one quarter, funds from the permit processing contingency account may be transferred to operating accounts and utilized for processing permits as set forth in this ordinance.

SECTION 4. The executive shall report expenditures pursuant to this policy each 2 quarter to the chair of the budget and fiscal management committee or its successor. The report shall include documentation of actual receipts and increased permit activity, projected 3 receipts and permit activity, and a proposed expenditure plan if expenditures from the 4 5 contingency fund are expected to continue into the next quarter.
