7 AN ORDINANCE relating to zoning; exempting Christmas tree
8 lots in the Rural zone from the requirements of a temporary use
9 permit; and amending Ordinance 10870, Section 548, and K.C.C.
10 21A.32.110.

12 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

13
14 SECTION 1. Ordinance 10870, Section 548, as amended, and K.C.C. 21A.32.110 are

15 each hereby amended to read as follows:

16 Temporary use permits - exemptions to permit requirement.

17 A. The following uses shall be exempt from requirements for a temporary use permit
18 when located in the RB, CB, NB, O, or I zones for the time period specified below:

19 1. Uses not to exceed a total of 30 days each calendar year:

- 20 a. Christmas tree lots;
21 b. Fireworks stands; and
22 c. Produce stands.

23 2. Uses not to exceed a total of 14 days each calendar year:

- 24 a. Amusement rides, carnivals, or circuses;
25 b. Community festivals; and
26 c. Parking lot sales.

27 B. Any use not exceeding a cumulative total of 2 days each calendar year shall be
28 exempt from requirements for a temporary use permit.

1 C. Any community event held in a public park and not exceeding a period of 7 days
2 shall be exempt from requirements for a temporary use permit.

3 D. Christmas tree sales not exceeding a total of 30 days each calendar year when located
4 on Rural Area (RA) zoned property with legally established non-residential uses shall be
5 exempt from requirements for a temporary use permit.
