STATEMENT OF FACTS:

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting the vacation of the county right-of-way at the intersection of 73rd Avenue Northeast and Northeast 112th Street hereinafter described.
- 2. The department of transportation, road services division has notified various utilities serving the area and was advised that Puget Sound Power and Light Company, GTE Telephone Operations and Viacom North Communications have secured easements over the proposed vacation area. No other utility easements are required.
- 3. The land use services division of the department of development and environmental services has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not conflict with the principals and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. The department of transportation, road services division found evidence that the vacation area is open as a road. A search of the records indicates public funds have been expended for the maintenance of the subject right-of-way. The department of transportation considers the subject portion of the right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

5. The right-of-way is classified "B-Class" and in accordance with K.C.C. 14.40.020 the compensation due King County is based on seventy-five percent of the appraised value of the adjoining lands which may be determined from records of the department of assessments. King County is in receipt of \$19,437.00 from the petitioner.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the office of the hearing examiner on the $\frac{187}{\text{Cugust}}$, $19\underline{97}$.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.
