ORDINANCE NO. **12917**

AN ORDINANCE adopting fee schedules for the Work, Education and Release program; Jail Health Services medical services co-payments; special detention facility 24- and 48-hour commitments; to comply with Ordinance 12715, Section 1, and adding new sections to K.C.C. 2.73.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

NEW SECTION. SECTION 1. There is hereby added to K.C.C. 2.73 a new section to read as follows:

A. **Work, Education and Release and Electronic Home Detention Fees.** The following fee schedule for the community corrections programs including Work, Education and Release and Electronic Home Detention program are hereby adopted:

1. Program participants engaged in job search pay \$7.50 per day, except for in-custody community corrections program eligible inmates who pay \$4.00 per day for the first two weeks, then \$7.50 per day thereafter. Inmates who were previously employed, became unemployed while on the program, and are placed in a job search category pay \$7.50 per day.

2. Program participants enrolled in educational programs pay \$3.00 per day for high school and GED program, and \$8.00 per day while enrolled in college classes, trade or technical schools.

3. Program participants who receive outside treatment pay \$7.00 per day.

4. Out-of-County program participants shall be charged the same daily rate as charged to contracting agencies.

B. Jail Health Services. Incarcerated individuals pay a \$5.00 co-payment for medical care when they are seen by a nurse or dental staff in response to a request for medical or dental services. The fee-for-service program is based upon the principle that access to health care will be available to all inmates regardless of their ability to pay.

C. Special Detention Facility 24- and 48-hour commitments. The following fee schedule shall apply for special detention facility 24- and 48-hour commitments:

A person who is housed at the North Rehabilitation Facility pursuant to a court-ordered 24-to-48 hour commitment upon a conviction of violating RCW 46.61.502 or SMC 11.56.02000 or upon a conviction of RCW 46.61.504 or SMC 11.56.02008, shall pay a daily housing fee according to the following guidelines with the lowest allowable payment set at 125% of the federal poverty guidelines adjusted for number of persons in household:




