ORDINANCE NO. 12928

AN ORDINANCE relating to school impact fees; adopting the Capital Facilities Plans of the Tahoma, Federal Way, Riverview, Issaquah, Snoqualmie Valley, Highline, Lake Washington, Kent, Northshore, Enumclaw, and Fife School Districts as subelements of the capital facilities element of the King County Comprehensive Plan for purposes of implementing the school impact fee program; establishing school impact fees to be collected by King County on behalf of the districts; amending Ordinance 10122, Sections 2 and 3, as amended and K.C.C. 27.44.010 and K.C.C. 20.12.460, Ordinance 10470, Section 2, as amended and K.C.C. 20.12.461, Ordinance 10472, Section 2, as amended and K.C.C. 20.12.462, Ordinance 10633, Section 2, as amended and K.C.C. 20.12.463, Ordinance 10722, Sections 2 and 3, as amended and K.C.C. 20.12.464 and K.C.C. 20.12.465, Ordinance 10790, Section 2, as amended and K.C.C. 20.12.466, Ordinance 10982, Section 2, as amended and K.C.C. 20.12.467, Ordinance 11148, Section 2, as amended and K.C.C. 20.12.468, Ordinance 12063, Section 11, as amended and K.C.C. 20.12.469, and Ordinance 12532, Section 12, and K.C.C. 20.12.470.

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Authority. This ordinance is adopted to implement King County Comprehensive Plan policies, Washington State Growth Management Act, and King County Ordinance No. 10162 with respect to Tahoma School District, Federal Way School District, Riverview School District, Issaquah School District, Snoqualmie Valley School District, Highline School District, Lake Washington School District, Kent School District, Northshore School District, Enumclaw School District, and Fife School District. This ordinance is necessary to address identified impacts of development on the districts in order to protect the public health, safety and welfare, and to implement King County's

authority to impose school impact fees pursuant to RCW 82.02.050 through RCW 82.02.080.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 10122, Section 3, as amended and K.C.C. 20.12.460 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Tahoma School District Capital Facilities Plan. The Tahoma School District No. 409 Capital Facilities Plan ((1996-97 to 2001-02, April 22, 1996)) 1997-98 to 2002-03, May 1, 1997 which is included in Attachment A and incorporated herein by reference, is adopted as a subelement of the capital facilities element of the Comprehensive Plan for King County.

SECTION 3. Ordinance 10470, Section 2, as amended and K.C.C. 20.12.461 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Federal Way School District Capital Facilities Plan. The Federal Way School District No. 210 ((1995/96)) 1996/97 Capital Facilities Plan, ((revised April 1996)) April 14, 1997 which is included in Attachment B and incorporated herein by reference, is adopted as a subelement of the capital facilities element of the Comprehensive Plan for King County.

SECTION 4. Ordinance 10472, Section 2, as amended and K.C.C. 20.12.462 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Riverview School District Capital Facilities Plan. The Riverview School District No. 407 Capital Facilities Plan April 1, ((1996)) 1997 adopted March ((26, 1996)) 25, 1997, revised May ((14, 1996)) 1, 1997, which is included in Attachment C and is incorporated herein by reference, is adopted as a subelement of the capital facilities element of the Comprehensive Plan for King County.

B. County's Administrative Costs. The county's costs of administering the school impact fee program shall be sixty-five dollars per dwelling unit and shall be paid by the applicant to the county as part of the development application fee.

C. Effective Date. The school impact fees established in K.C.C. 27.44.010 (A) shall become effective on January 1, ((1997)) 1998.

SECTION 14. Severability. Should any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance be held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the ordinance or the application of the invalidated provision to other persons or circumstances.
