AN ORDINANCE approving and adopting two Memoranda of Agreement negotiated by and between King County and Amalgamated Transit Union, Local 587 (Computer Operators), representing employees in the department of information and administrative services; and establishing the effective date of said agreement.

SECTION 1. The two Memoranda of Agreement negotiated between King County and the Amalgamated Transit Union, Local 587 (Computer Operators), representing employees in the department of information and administrative services and attached hereto is hereby approved and adopted by this reference made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. Terms and conditions of said agreements shall be effective from November 1, 1995 through and including October 31, 1998.


AGREEMENT
by and between
COUNTY OF KING, WASHINGTON
and
AMALGAMATED TRANSIT UNION, LOCAL 587
(Representing Computer Operators in King County's Information
and Telecommunications Services Division, Department of Information and
Administrative Services)

THIS AGREEMENT is by and between the COUNTY OF KING, WASHINGTON, hereinafter referred to as the County, and the AMALGAMATED TRANSIT UNION, LOCAL 587, hereinafter referred to as the Union.

It is understood and agreed by and between the County and the Union that all the terms and conditions of the Labor Agreement by and between the County and the Union having expired October 31, 1995 and extended for the period from November 1, 1995 through October 31, 1997, be again extended through October 31, 1998, except for changes hereinafter set forth:

- Effective November 1, 1997 the hourly rates of pay in effect as of October 31, 1997 for each classification covered by this Agreement shall be increased by a cost of living adjustment of 1.86%.
- Effective November 1, 1997 a shift differential of \$0.75 shall apply to employees who work a regular day shift for all unscheduled hours worked beyond 6:00 p.m., scheduled second shift work, and for Computer and Communication Services Division employees, regularly scheduled third shift (graveyard) work. Employees will not receive this differential for those hours for which they receive overtime pay. Employees working alternative work schedules are not eligible for shift differential.


The Union has given its commitment that it will make its best effort to coordinate an attempt by all the unions with County contracts to resolve the various jurisdiction concerns that presently exist.

THIS AGREEMENT is by and between the COUNTY OF KING, WASHINGTON, hereinafter referred to as the County, and the AMALGAMATED TRANSIT UNION, LOCAL 587, hereinafter referred to as the Union.

It is understood and agreed by and between the County and the Union that all the terms and conditions of the Labor Agreement by and between the County and the Union having expired October 31, 1995 is extended for the period from November 1, 1995 through October 31, 1997, except for the cost-of-living adjustments which shall be as hereinafter set forth:


Effective November 1, 1995 the hourly rates of pay in effect as of October 31, 1995 for each classification covered by this Agreement shall be increased by 1.63%.

Effective November 1, 1996 the hourly rates of pay in effect as of October 31, 1996 for each classification covered by this Agreement shall be increased by 2.69%.
