### STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of that portion of John J. Hallworth Road (County Road 583) hereinafter described.
- 2. The John J. Hallworth Road (County Road 583) was established in 1901. On June 25, 1901 a release of claims for the establishment of the subject road was recorded in volume 272 of deeds, page 640, records of King County, Washington.
- 3. The recorded release of claims did not convey to King County any right title or interest in the established right-of-way.
- 4. The release of claims and the assessor's map showing the established roadway have created a cloud as to whether the road has ever been opened and/or utilized as a County road right-of-way.
- 5. The department of transportation, road services division has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements are not required in the vacation area.
- 6. The department of transportation found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicate that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The department of transportation considers the subject right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
- 7. The right-of-way is classified "D Class" and in accordance with King County Code 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is based on administrative cost. King County is in receipt of \$200 from the petitioner.
