ORDINANCE NO. **13013**

AN ORDINANCE relating to no shooting areas, establishing a no shooting area within the Hill voting precinct in an area between Woodinville and Duvall, and adding a new section to K.C.C. 12.68

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The shooting of firearms is prohibited and a no shooting area is established within the Hill voting precinct between Woodinville and Duvall and described as follows:

A. Bounded on the north by the King County line, on the east by 224<sup>TH</sup> Avenue NE, on the south by the Woodinville-Duvall Road, 226<sup>th</sup> Place NE and NE 180<sup>th</sup> Street and on the west by the Paradise Lake Road.
