ORDINANCE NO. 13019

AN ORDINANCE establishing fees for vactor waste disposal to be paid by non-Road Services Division entities for the decanting of vactor liquids and dumping of vactor solids at King County Road Services Division vactor waste disposal sites; and adding a new chapter to Title 14.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby added to K.C.C. title14 a new chapter to read as follows:

Regional Vactor Waste Disposal:

Establishment and purpose. The King County council hereby establishes a fee relating to the regional vactor waste disposal plan. Effective January 1, 1998 all non-road services division entities using county operated liquid and solid vactor waste disposal facilities shall pay the service fees set forth in the following schedule:

Authorization. The director of the department of transportation is hereby authorized to assess a fee for vactor waste disposal at county operated liquid and solid waste disposal facilities.

Fees. Service fees for the use of county operated vactor waste disposal facilities shall be \$46 per delivery for liquid and \$43 per ton for solid vactor waste material.

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1	Procedure for collection. The fee shall be collected by the department of
2	transportation roads services division which shall establish a procedure for these fees, and
3	the deposit thereof in the County Road Fund in accordance with RCW 43.09.220.
