ORDINANCE NO. **13019**

AN ORDINANCE establishing fees for vector waste disposal to be paid by non-Road Services Division entities for the decanting of vector liquids and dumping of vector solids at King County Road Services Division vector waste disposal sites; and adding a new chapter to Title 14.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby added to K.C.C. title 14 a new chapter to read as follows:

**Regional Vector Waste Disposal:**

**Establishment and purpose.** The King County council hereby establishes a fee relating to the regional vector waste disposal plan. Effective January 1, 1998 all non-road services division entities using county operated liquid and solid vector waste disposal facilities shall pay the service fees set forth in the following schedule:

**Authorization.** The director of the department of transportation is hereby authorized to assess a fee for vector waste disposal at county operated liquid and solid waste disposal facilities.

**Fees.** Service fees for the use of county operated vector waste disposal facilities shall be \$46 per delivery for liquid and \$43 per ton for solid vector waste material.


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Procedure for collection. The fee shall be collected by the department of transportation roads services division which shall establish a procedure for these fees, and the deposit thereof in the County Road Fund in accordance with RCW 43.09.220.


INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 15th day of December, 1997.
