AN ORDINANCE relating to the establishment of the Issaquah-Fall City Road from a point south of Southeast Black Nugget Road to Southeast Issaquah-Pine Lake Road.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The director of the department of transportation has made an examination of Issaquah-Fall City Road from a point approximately 360 feet south of Southeast Black Nugget Road to the Southeast Issaquah-Pine Lake Road along the course and description set forth below and has made a favorable report upon the same, as required by R.C.W. 36.81.050.

SECTION 2. Said road shown on attachment "A" shall be established not less than 100 feet in width, having 50 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Commencing at the southwest corner of section 22, township 24 north, range 6 east, W.M. thence South 88°24'57" East a distance of 476.30 feet along the south line of said section 22; thence North 54°34'34" East a distance of 2389.54 feet to the point of beginning of this establishment and the beginning of a 720.00 foot radius tangent curve to the left; thence along the arc of said 720.00 foot radius curve through a central angle of 38°43'08", an arc distance of 486.56 feet; thence North 15°51'26" East a distance of 869.58 feet to the beginning of a 1536.00 foot radius tangent curve to the right; thence along the arc of said 1536.00 foot radius curve through a central angle of 33°43'18", an arc distance of 904.02 feet; thence North 49°34'44" East a distance of 401.62 feet to the intersection of Issaquah-Pine Lake Road and Issaquah-Fall City Road and the terminus of this establishment; thence continuing North 49°34'44" East a distance of 2153.90
