STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of that portion of 184th Avenue Southeast hereinafter described.
- 2. The department of transportation has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements are not required.
- 3. The department of transportation found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The department of transportation considers the subject right-of-way unnecessary as part of the county road system and believes the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
- 4. The right-of-way is classified "C-Class" and in accordance with K.C.C. 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is based on fifty percent of the appraised value of the adjoining lands which may be determined from records of the department of assessments. King County is in receipt of \$3,709.97 from the petitioner.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.
