10. The FAA, through Part 161 of the Federal Aviation Regulations, offers a procedure for studying specific proposals to restrict airport operations as a method of reducing noise.

11. The council and executive understand the importance of, and are committed to maintaining, a high-quality, functional airport for area businesses and workers such as the Boeing Company and other aviation-related family wage businesses.

12. The council and executive believe that it is possible to operate a high-quality airport while minimizing impacts on neighborhoods.

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created a Airport Noise Containment Reserve Subfund within the Airport Construction Fund at the King County International Airport. This fund shall be a first tier fund as described in K.C.C. 4.10.010. The manager of the King County International Airport shall be the fund manager.

SECTION 2. The purpose of the Airport Noise Containment Reserve Subfund is to provide for the revenues and expenditures associated with capital projects, such as a "hush house", to be selected and funded to provide noise containment for the King County International Airport.

SECTION 3. An additional \$500,000 shall be appropriated from the Airport operating fund balance for the design of a noise containment facility such as a "hush house" and an additional \$500,000 for the capital projects related to master plan and noise remedies studies.

SECTION 4. A transfer of five million dollars from the Airport fund balance into the reserve fund is hereby appropriated. Funds from this reserve fund shall not be expended until a satisfactory facility design has been completed.

SECTION 5. Ordinance 12926, Section 91, as amended, shall be amended as follows: SECTION 91. AIRPORT CONSTRUCTION TRANSFER – From the
