13373 ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to levying of property taxes of King County for the year 1999.

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The county assessor of King County has certified to the metropolitan King County council that the assessed valuation of the County of King as finally equalized amounts to \$149,083,182,982 and as adjusted for senior citizens exemptions provided for in RCW 84.36.381 and for omitted assessments in accordance with RCW 84.40.080 is \$147,319,496,082.

SECTION 2. The metropolitan King County council finds that the levies necessary to fund estimated expenditures for the year 1999, less the total of estimated revenues from sources other than taxation, including available surplus and such expenditures as are to be net from bond warrant issues, be and the same are fixed as follows:

SECTION 4. The levy amount passed today for the county road district will not increase the tax rate compared to the 1997 levy. The council action today will result in maintaining the same tax rate for the county road district levy that was used in the 1997 levy.

Previously the council authorized an increase in the county road district regular property tax 1998 levy for collection in 1999 over the 1997 levy for collection of taxes in 1998 of 1,728,747 dollars or an increase of 3.7%. With the passage of this ordinance the council is reducing that authorized increase to 492,944 dollars, which is a percentage increase of 1.1%. This is exclusive
