3 AN ORDINANCE relating to regulatory fees; ratifying,  
4 confirming and readopting the regulatory fees adopted in  
5 Ordinances 13327, 13329, 13332, 13334 and 13335 as part of  
6 the 1999 annual King County budget.

7 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

8 SECTION 1. Findings of fact.

9 A. The Council hereby finds that an inadvertent error in the publication of legal  
10 notice was caused by the failure of the Seattle Times to publish the notice of public hearing  
11 on fees on the date directed by the Clerk. As a result, the required ten days' notice of a  
12 public hearing was not given for several proposed ordinances for which public hearings  
13 were held on November 16, 1998. Notice for an additional public hearing held November  
14 23, 1998, was published in the Seattle Times on November 18, 1998, for Proposed  
15 Ordinances 98-628, 98-630, 98-635, 98-637 and 98-638 and on November 19, 1998, for  
16 Proposed Ordinances 98-640, 98-641 and 98-642. These fees, as amended, which were  
17 proposed in these ordinances were incorporated by striking amendment into and duly  
18 adopted in Ordinances 13327, 13329, 13332, 13334 and 13335 on November 23, 1998.

19 B. On \_\_\_\_\_, a public hearing was held on the present ordinance, which  
20 ratifies and confirms the previous adoption of and readopts the regulatory fees originally  
21 proposed in the ordinances listed in subsection A of this section and adopted in Ordinances

1 13327, 13329, 13332, 13334 and 13335 as part of the 1999 annual King County budget.

2 At least ten days' prior notice by publication was given for this hearing in the Seattle

3 Times on December 1, 1998.

4 C. The regulatory fees readopted herein are as follows:

5 1. Ordinance 13327 (Proposed Substitute Ordinance 98-628 which  
6 incorporates Proposed Ordinances 98-628, 98-640, 98-641 and 98-642) relating to property  
7 services division fees; increasing fees for right-of-way construction permits; increasing  
8 fees for special use permits; increasing fees for fees right-of-way franchises for utilities;  
9 and increasing fees for permits for public and private utilities;

10 2. Ordinance 13329 (Proposed Substitute Ordinance 98-630) revising roads  
11 maintenance utility inspection fees for right-of-way construction permits;

12 3. Ordinance 13332 (Proposed Substitute Ordinance 98-635) relating to  
13 fees for development permits, approvals, inspections and environmental review issued or  
14 performed by the department of development and environmental services; restructuring  
15 fees for building permits, grading permits, clearing permits, right-of-way use permits, fire  
16 code permits and inspections, short subdivisions, subdivisions, binding site plans,  
17 environmental checklists and environmental impact statements, sensitive area reviews,  
18 zone reclassifications, conditional use permits, variances, special use permits, shoreline  
19 permits, shoreline exemptions, urban plan developments and current use approvals;

20 4. Ordinance 13334 (Proposed Substitute Ordinance 98-637) relating to  
21 taxicab and for-hire vehicle fees, increasing fees; and

22 5. Ordinance 13335 (Proposed Substitute Ordinance 98-638) relating to  
23 animal and pet fees.
