ORDINANCE NO. 13417

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the conveyance of property for right of way purposes along SR 18, in Council District 12, to the state of Washington.

STATEMENT OF FACTS:

- 1. King County acquired a 2.62 acre property through trade with the state of Washington in 1981 for general county purposes and subsequently transferred the property to the King County department of parks and recreation for trail purposes.
- 2. The state of Washington currently has a road project along SR 18 and requires a portion of the subject property for road right of way.
- 3. The road right of way needed by the state consists of 38,074 sq. ft. or 0.87 acres. The value of the right of way based on a current appraisal is \$0.66 per square foot or \$25,300.
- 4. The county's department of parks and recreation has plans in the future to establish a trail connection through the remaining portion of the property.
- 5. The state has assured King County that the remaining property can accommodate both agencies' proposed projects and has provided cross section drawings reflecting such.
- 6. The department of parks and recreation supports this sale as long as it conforms to drawings provided by the state and that the state agrees to grant any necessary slope easements to King County, when appropriate.
- 7. The subject property is considered surplus to the needs of the department of parks and recreation and the conveyance of this property to the state of Washington is considered to be in the best interest of the citizens of King County.

8. The portion of the subject property being acquired by the state, because of its size and configuration, is not suitable for affordable housing.

9. The county may dispose of county property to another governmental agency by negotiation, upon such terms as may be agreed upon and for such consideration as may be deemed by the county to be adequate under K.C.C. 4.56.140.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County executive is hereby authorized to execute the necessary documents to convey the following described property located in council district 12 to the state of Washington for the sum of \$25,300:
