ORDINANCE NO. **13456**

AN ORDINANCE approving the city of Bellevue 1998 Water Comprehensive Plan.

PREAMBLE:

K.C.C. chapter 13.24 requires approval of comprehensive plans for water utilities as a prerequisite for granting right-of-way franchises and approval of right-of-way construction permits.

The city of Bellevue 1998 Water Comprehensive Plan (plan) discusses water utility service to one hundred fourteen thousand citizens currently living in both incorporated and unincorporated urban areas near the city of Bellevue. The plan also provides water demand forecasts for the next twenty years and includes capital improvement proposals to replace aging infrastructure.

The King County utilities technical review committee (UTRC) reviews and conditionally approved the plan on September 9, 1998. The conditions of UTRC approval, technical changes to the plan, have been met and are reflected in the final version.

The city of Bellevue prepared a determination of nonsignificance for the plan on November 19, 1998, in accordance with the State Environmental Policy Act.

The City of Bellevue adopted the plan on December 14, 1998.

The UTRC recommends that the council approve the plan.



SECTION 1. The city of Bellevue 1998 Water Comprehensive Plan, Attachment A, is hereby approved without conditions.


