## ORDINANCE NO. <u>13598</u>

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$2,475,000 from Washington State Salmon Recovery Office grants for the acquisition or restoration, or both, of salmon habitat; and amending the 1999 Budget Ordinance, Ordinance 13340, Section 119, as amended, and Ordinance 13340, Section 119, Attachment 3, as amended.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There are hereby approved and adopted appropriations of \$2,106,720 to the King County non-bond open space fund and \$368,280 to the SWM CIP non-bond subfund.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 13340, Section 119, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

<u>CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM</u> - From the several capital improvement project funds there are hereby appropriated and authorized to be disbursed the following amounts for the specific projects identified in Attachment 3 of Ordinance 13340.
