## ORDINANCE NO. 13608

AN ORDINANCE relating to the use of a King County park, allowing the director of parks and recreation to issue a special use permit allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within a confined area of the Cloverleaf Ballfield Complex at Fort Dent Park during the Men's Masters 45 & Over Slow Pitch Softball National Championship tournament on September 10 through 12, 1999; and amending Ordinance 6798, Section 64, as amended, and K.C.C. 7.12.640.

## **PREAMBLE**

Team Seattle National Events Committee (Team Seattle) is hosting the Amateur Softball Association's (ASA) Men's Masters 45 & Over Slow Pitch Softball National Championship tournament at Fort Dent Park September 10 through 12, 1999.

Fort Dent Park has been the host site for two previous ASA national championships: the 1981 Women's Class A Slow Pitch and the 1985 Men's Major Fast Pitch.

The 1985 Men's Major Fast Pitch tournament was granted permission to serve alcohol at Fort Dent during the 1985 tournament.

Team Seattle has requested to use a portion of the Fort Dent softball complex for a hospitality site and to serve alcoholic beverages to specific tournament patrons at the site during the national championship.

Team Seattle has agreed to compensate the county twenty percent of the gross sales of the alcoholic beverages for this privilege.

K.C.C. 7.12.640 prohibits the selling, opening, possessing, and consuming of alcoholic beverages at nonauthorized sites, including Fort Dent Park.

To support the softball national championship tournament, the county agrees to issue a special use permit allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the designated hospitality site between September 10 through 12, 1999.

A one-time exception to K.C.C. 7.12.640 is necessary to authorize the park system to issue a limited and restricted special use permit allowing sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages at a designated site within Fort Dent Park ballfield complex during the Men's Masters 45 & Over Slow Pitch Softball National Championship Tournament.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An exception to K.C.C. 7.12.640 is hereby granted, authorizing the executive through the director of parks and recreation to issue a special use permit to Team Seattle National Events Committee, thereby allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages at a designated hospitality site at Fort Dent Park, on September 10 through 12, 1999.

SECTION 2. The serving and consumption of alcoholic beverages must be confined to the designated location, and must conform to the requirements of the Washington State Liquor Control Board under Title 66 RCW.

SECTION 3. The executive and director of parks and recreation shall assure that the Team Seattle National Events Committee has adequate insurance coverage and that the county is named as an additional insured by the Team Seattle National Events Committee before a permit is issued.

SECTION 4. Ordinance 6798, Section 64, as amended, and K.C.C. 7.12.640 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

Alcoholic beverages. Selling, opening( $(x_3)$ ) or possessing alcoholic beverages in an open container, or consuming any alcoholic beverage in a King County park, recreation area( $(x_3)$ ) or associated marine area is prohibited except in the following designated areas subject to approval by the manager and under the following conditions:

A. The sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages is permissible in the club house at the Enumclaw golf course.

B.The sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages is permissible for special use permit groups at the King County fairgrounds, ((provided that)) if the activities conform to the requirements of the Washington State Liquor Control Board ((pursuant to)) under Title 66((-7)) RCW

C. The sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages is permissible at designated indoor and outdoor locations within Marymoor Park, King County Aquatic Center and indoors at the Lake Wilderness Center, Gold Creek Lodge in Woodinville and Issaquah Lodge at Beaver Lake by special use permit groups, ((provided that)) if the activities conform to the requirements of the Washington State Liquor Control Board ((pursuant to)) under Title 66((5)) RCW, and that ((such)) the serving and consumption is confined to the designated location. The director shall designate the locations within the park ((fand recreational facility)) and recreational facility where ((such)) the activity is permissible. The director of parks and recreation may issue a special use permit to the Team Seattle National Events Committee, allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages by
