#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

- A petition has been filed requesting vacation of that portion of Southeast North Bend Way (formerly known as SR 90 – Old Primary State Highway No. 2 Route) hereinafter described.
- The department of transportation notified the various utility companies serving the area and has been advised that easements were not required within the vacation area.
- 3. The department of transportation's records indicates that Southeast North Bend Way (formerly known as SR 90 - Old Primary State Highway No. 2 Route) has a paved surface and has historically been maintained by King County. The records indicate that public funds have been expended for its maintenance. The department of transportation considers the subject right-of-way useless as part of the County road system and believes the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

4. The right-of-way is classified "A-Class," and in accordance with King County Code 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is based on 75 percent of the assessed value of the adjoining lands which may be determined from records of the department of assessments. King County is in receipt of \$19,710.00 from the petitioner.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the office of the hearing examiner on the 20th day of October, 1999.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.
