

AN ORDINANCE approving a franchise for the city of Redmond to construct, operate and maintain a sewer system in council district 3, and authorizing the executive to execute the franchise agreement.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS:

- 1. The city of Redmond has filed an application for a franchise in council district 3 to construct, operate and maintain a sewer system to serve primarily residential and some commercial areas in accordance with RCW 36.55.010 and K.C.C. chapter 6.27.
- 2. King County council Ordinance 12964 approved the city's comprehensive plan on January 5, 1998.
- 3. The application has been referred to the relevant county departments for review.
- 4. The King County executive has recommended approval of the franchise.
- 5. The utilities technical review committee reviewed and approved the city's franchise, legal description and map on June 11, 1997.

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The granting of a franchise to the city of Redmond to construct, operate and maintain a sewer system within King County is hereby approved. The King County executive is authorized to enter into and execute the sewer system franchise, which
