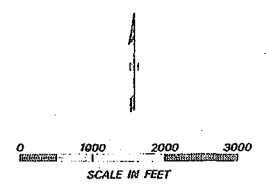

15 INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 6th day of December, 1999.





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

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

**Between
King County
and
Service Employees International Union
Public Safety Employees, Local 519
Representing Non-Commissioned Bargaining Unit Employees
in the
Departments of Public Health, King County Sheriff's Office, Adult Detention, and
Community and Human Services
Concerning
Training Duty for Data Technicians**

King County and Service Employees International Union, Public Safety Employees, Local 519 agree to the following terms with respect to the continuation of "training duty" pay for Data Technicians:

1. Data Technicians were covered under the Communications Center/911 Collective Bargaining Agreement until 6/17/98 and as such were eligible for training duty pay under Article 7, Section 4.
2. Effective 6/17/98 Data Technicians were transferred to the Non-Commissioned bargaining unit and were no longer eligible for training duty pay.
3. Training pay provisions for the Non-Commissioned bargaining unit have been negotiated but will not take effect until 1/1/2000.
4. For operational reasons, it is the desire of the Sheriff's Office to continue the training duty pay for Data Technicians as outlined in the 911 Collective Bargaining Agreement through the remainder of 1999.

5. Local 519 has no objection to the continuation of this premium through 12/31/99 for Data Technicians who qualify.

Therefore, it is hereby agreed that the Sheriff's Office Communications Center is authorized to pay the training duty benefits to Data Technicians who qualify as outlined in Article 7, Section 4 of the 911 Collective Bargaining Agreement.
