## Ordinance 13711

AN ORDINANCE relating to bridge names, changing the name of the 1 "14th/16th Avenue South Bridge" to the "South Park Bridge". 2 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY: 3 SECTION 1. The bridge designated "14th/16th Avenue South Bridge" described 4 as crossing the Duwamish waterway in the South Park area of metropolitan Seattle and 5 generally lying between East Marginal Way South and South Cloverdale Street in the 6 7 Northeast quarter of Section 32, Township 24 North, Range 4 East, W.M. and connecting 8 the 14th Avenue South roadway corridor to the 16th Avenue South roadway corridor is hereby redesignated in its entirety as the "South Park Bridge." 9 10 SECTION 2. If at any time in the future the bridge is replaced, that bridge will continue to be designated the "South Park Bridge". 11 12 SECTION 3. The director of the department of transportation shall accomplish any necessary sign changes. 13
