1 AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of
2 \$147,500 to the grants fund from the United States
3 Environmental Protection Agency, Region 10, for a
4 Brownfields job training pilot project administered by the
5 office of regional policy and planning; and amending the
6 1999 Budget Ordinance, Ordinance 13340, Section 94, as
7 amended.

8 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

9 SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation
10 of \$147,500 to the grants fund from from the United States Environmental Protection
11 Agency (EPA), Region 10, to fund a Brownfields job training pilot project, administered
12 by the office of regional policy and planning. The grant will provide for the training of
13 low-income residents as environmental cleanup technicians and offer an advanced
14 environmental assessment career pathway.

15 SECTION 2. Ordinance 13340, Section 94, as amended, is hereby amended by


