BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 9391, as amended, and K.C.C. 1.08.020 are each hereby
amended to read as follows:

Inspectors and judges – compensation. A. The manager, records and elections
division, is authorized and directed to compensate election inspectors and judges at ((the
following rates:

Activity:	Effective 1/1/94	Effective 9/1/97
Polling place staffing	75.95	\$79.83
Election official workshop	\$ 9.80	\$10.30
Inspector transfer of ballots to election depot	\$23.00	\$25.00
Judge accompanying inspector to depot	\$ 4.90	\$ 5.15

~~At no time shall these rates, computed on an hourly scale, be less than either the state
or federal minimum wage, whichever is greater on hourly scale, which shall not be less
than)) either the state or federal minimum hourly wage, whichever is greater.~~



Attendance at training classes	3




