6 **STATEMENT OF FACTS:**

- 7 1. On June 19, 2000, the council adopted Ordinance 13873 making
8 September 2000 transit service changes.
9 2. Before adoption, an amendment was made to pages A-15 and A-16 of
10 Attachment A to Ordinance 13873, which described new bus route 341.
11 Attachment A inadvertently included a description and map of Route 341
12 that did not correctly reflect the amendment.
13 3. An action of the council is necessary to correct route 341.

14 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:**

15 SECTION 1. The September 2000 public transportation service improvements
16 for King County, substantially as described in Attachment A to this ordinance, are hereby
17 approved to replace pages A-15 and A-16 or Attachment A to Ordinance 13873.



County Council on 7/10/00, by the following vote:



AMENDED 7/6/2000

ROUTES: 341, 342

OBJECTIVES:

1. Provide replacement service for existing Route 340 customers with destinations not served by Sound Transit's regional ST Express Routes 530, 532, 535.

IMPACTED SERVICE AREA:

Shoreline, Lake Forest Park, Kenmore, Bothell, North Creek, Bellevue, Newcastle and Renton

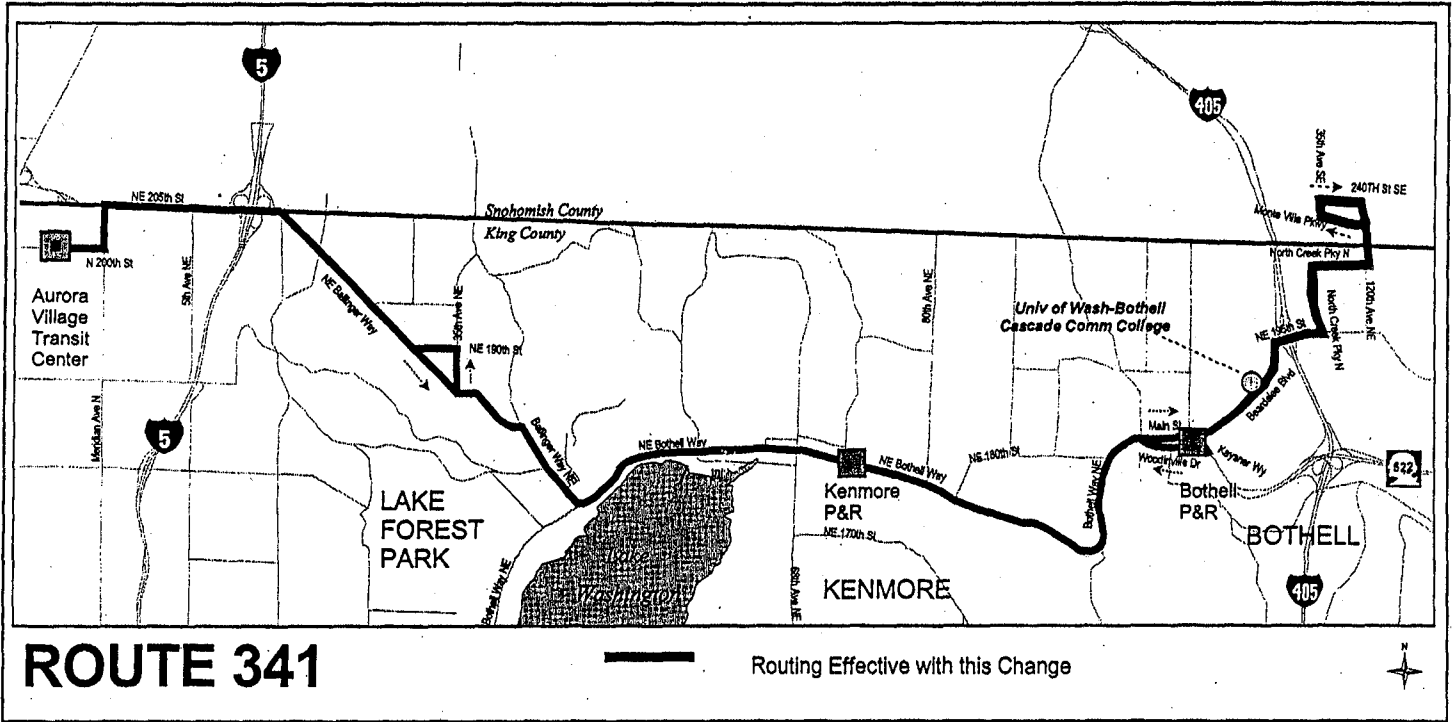
SERVICE CHANGE:

1. Route 341 would provide two-way replacement coverage in Shoreline, Lake Forest Park, Kenmore and Bothell, operating along the existing Route 340 routing between the Aurora Village Transit Center and the Bothell park-and-ride. On weekdays the Route 341 would operate beyond the Bothell park-and-ride to the North Creek and Monte Villa business parks via the University of Washington/Cascade Community College Campus. From the Bothell Park and Ride the Route 341 will operate via Beardslee Boulevard, NE 195th, North Creek Pkwy, 120th AV NE 39th AV SE), 242 St SE (Monte Villa Pkwy, 35th AV.

The Route 341 span of service would approximate the existing Route 340 span. During peak periods the Route 341 runs on thirty-minute headways. During off-peak hours the Route 341 will operate hourly (mid-days, evenings and weekends.) Weekends the Route 341 will operate hourly from approximately 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 PM.

2. Route 342 would begin at the Aurora Village Transit Center and follow the Route 340 routing, making the same stops in Shoreline, Lake Forest Park, Kenmore, Bothell, and along I-405 including the Bellevue Transit Center, Newport Hills park-and-ride, and the Park Avenue North Renton Boeing stops; it would serve the Wilburton park-and-ride lot instead of the South Bellevue park-and-ride. Route 342 would operate four (4) southbound trips in the a.m. and four (4) northbound trips in the p.m. Trip times will start with the earliest trip by current Route 340N.
