BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation of \$500,000 to SWM CIP fund 3292 to be funded from fees collected in the rural portion of the SWM service area, also known as rural drainage program fees. This appropriation increases the transfer of \$1,127,900 authorized by the council on January 10,2000, in Ordinance 13705, Section 1, by an additional \$500,000, making the transfer a total of \$1,627,900 from SWM fund 121 to SWM CIP non-bond fund 3292. This appropriation shall be expended as follows: \$75,000 to Shamrock Park; \$100,000 to Tuck Creek Phase II; \$100,000 to Shinglemill/Judkins Creek on Vashon/Maury Island; \$100,000 to LMO Cost Share Program; \$75,000 to Rural Community Partnership Grants Project; \$50,000 to Rural DHI project.
