1 AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of  
2 \$741,636 to public health from the public health fund for the  
3 operation of the Cedar Hills Medical Clinic and a  
4 supplemental disappropriation of \$522,976 to executive  
5 contingency for the cost of the September primary voter  
6 pamphlet and the operation of Cedar Hills Medical Clinic;  
7 and amending the Adopted 2000 Budget Ordinance,  
8 Ordinance 13678, Sections 40, 43, 79, and 86, as amended.

9 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

10 SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation  
11 of \$741,636 to the department of public health. \$522,976 shall be disappropriated from  
12 executive contingency; \$197,701 shall be disappropriated from MHCADS; \$75,656 shall  
13 be appropriated from current expense fund balance; and the remaining \$22,325 is patient  
14 generated revenues.

15 SECTION 2. Ordinance 13678, Section 40, as amended, is hereby amended by  
16 adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

17           EXECUTIVE CONTINGENCY – From the current expense fund there is hereby  
18       disappropriated from:

19           Executive contingency   (\$522,976)

20           SECTION 3. Ordinance 13678, Section 43, as amended, is hereby amended by  
21       adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

22           CX TRANSFERS – From the current expense fund there is hereby appropriated  
23       to:

24           CX transfers   \$521,267

25           SECTION 4. Ordinance 13678, Section 79, as amended, is hereby amended by  
26       adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

27           MHCADS/ ALCOHOLISM AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE – From the alcoholism  
28       and substance abuse services fund there is hereby disappropriated from:

29           MHCADS/alcoholism and substance abuse   (\$197,701)

30           The maximum number of additional FTEs for MHCADS/alcoholism and  
31       substance abuse shall be:   (4.0)

32           SECTION 5. Ordinance 13678, Section 86, as amended, is hereby amended by  
33       adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

34           PUBLIC HEALTH – From the public health fund there is hereby appropriated to:


