## Ordinance 13980

1	AN ORDINANCE relating to traffic control, setting the
2	speed limit at thirty-five miles per hour for Juanita-
3	Woodinville Way from 100th Avenue Northeast to the
4	western limited access boundary for state route 405, exit 22;
5	and amending Ordinance 5292, Schedule 3, as amended,
6	Ordinance 5292, Schedule 4, as amended, and Ordinance
7	5292, Schedule 4, as amended.

SECTION 1. Findings. The council finds that the traffic engineering section of the road services division has completed a corridor study to evaluate traffic and pedestrian safety improvements on Juanita-Woodinville Way Northeast. Uncontrolled crosswalks, traffic speeds, and pedestrian use were studied in the corridor. Fluorescent yellow-green pedestrian crossing signs were installed to increase driver awareness of crosswalks. The speed limit evaluation concluded that a speed limit reduction to thirty-five miles per hour on a portion of Juanita-Woodinville Way would be beneficial for both traffic and pedestrian

18	safety. The safety measure would foster compatibility of speed limits of nearby
19	100th Avenue Northeast and the commercial and residential land uses in the area.
20	SECTION 2. The maximum speed limit for Juanita-Woodinville Way from 100th
21	Avenue Northeast to the western limited access boundary for state route 405 at exit 22 is
22	hereby set at thirty-five miles per hour.
23	SECTION 3. After consideration of a traffic engineering study, as authorized by
24	RCW 46.90 and Ordinance 5292, Schedule 3, as amended, which establishes a maximum
25	speed limit of thirty-five miles per hour on county roads, is amended to add the following
26	location: Juanita-Woodinville Way from 100th Avenue Northeast to the western limited
27	access boundary of state route 405, exit 22.
28	SECTION 4. Ordinance 5292, Schedule 4, as amended, is amended to delete the
29	following location: Juanita-Woodinville Way from 100th Avenue Northeast to a point
30	800 feet southeast of 115th Avenue Northeast.
31	SECTION 5. The department of transportation shall post signs to give public
32	notice of the speed limit described in section 2 of this ordinance.
33	SECTION 6. The department of transportation shall give further study to the
34	potential for use of technical devices to enhance pedestrian safety at crosswalks within
