1 AN ORDINANCE related to the fees for the recording of  
2 official and public documents; amending Ordinance 1660,  
3 Sections 1-2, as amended, and K.C.C. 2.12.120.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. A. Section 2 of this ordinance proposes changes in the fees  
8 currently charged for the recording of official and public documents.

9 B. These fees are assessed pursuant to K.C.C. 2.99.030

10 SECTION 2. Ordinance 1660, Sections 1-2, as amended, and K.C.C. 2.12.120  
11 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

12 **Recording of official and public documents – ((F))fees.** The manager, records  
13 and elections division, shall charge such fees for the provision of recording services as  
14 are provided for county auditors in chapter 36.18 RCW and RCW 64.34.202. In addition,  
15 the following specific fees apply:

16 A. Record of survey. For land surveys, which shall be eighteen by twenty-four  
17 inches in size, the fee schedule is:



- 18           1. Basic fee for first page                   \$25.00
- 19           2. Department of natural resources fees   \$26.00
- 20           3. Centennial preservation fee               \$2.00
- 21           4. State archives fee                         \$1.00
- 22           5. Each additional page                      \$5.00

23           B. Short plats and boundary line adjustments. For short plats and boundary line  
24 adjustments, legal size or smaller, the manager, records and elections division, shall  
25 charge such fees as are provided for county auditors in chapter 36.18 RCW. For short  
26 plats and boundary line adjustments, eighteen by twenty-four inches in size, the fee  
27 schedule shall be the same as record of survey under K.C.C. 2.12.120A.

28           C. Record of monument. The record of monument shall be filed without charge  
29 on the standard form prescribed by the state Department of Natural Resources, Bureau of  
30 Surveys and Maps.

31           D. Reservation of condominium name. To reserve the right to use a specific  
32 name for a condominium, the fee is \$50.00. A reservation is subject to RCW 64.34.202.






