**Proposed No.** 2000-0584.1 Sponsors Nickels 1 AN ORDINANCE related to the fees for the recording of 2 official and public documents; amending Ordinance 1660, 3 Sections 1-2, as amended, and K.C.C. 2.12.120. 4 5 6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY: 7 SECTION 1. A. Section 2 of this ordinance proposes changes in the fees currently charged for the recording of official and public documents. 8 9 B. These fees are assessed pursuant to K.C.C. 2.99.030 10 SECTION 2. Ordinance 1660, Sections 1-2, as amended, and K.C.C. 2.12.120 11 are each hereby amended to read as follows: 12 Recording of official and public documents – ((F)) fees. The manager, records 13 and elections division, shall charge such fees for the provision of recording services as are provided for county auditors in chapter 36.18 RCW and RCW 64.34.202. In addition, 14 15 the following specific fees apply: 16 A. Record of survey. For land surveys, which shall be eighteen by twenty-four 17 inches in size, the fee schedule is:


