MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN KING COUNTY AND

WASHINGTON STATE NURSES ASSOCIATION Representing Employees in

Seattle-King County Public Health Department

Whereas, King County and Washington State Nurses Association are parties to a collective bargaining agreement that expires on December 31, 2000; and

Whereas, the parties have agreed to negotiate a successor to their current agreement; and

Whereas, the parties do not expect to conclude negotiations before the expiration date of the current agreement; and

Whereas, the parties agree that such successor agreement shall include a cost-of-living adjustment and modified provisions for the placement of a new employee on the salary range;

Now therefore the parties agree as follows:

All rates of pay in effect on December 31, 2000 shall be increased by a 3.11% cost of living adjustment effective January 1, 2001; and

Nothing in this Memorandum of Agreement shall preclude the parties from reaching an agreement for different salary ranges that may be in effect on or after January 1, 2001.
