1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the 2000 levy of property  
2 taxes in King County for collection in the year 2001; and  
3 amending Ordinance 14019, Section 3.  
4

5 **PREAMBLE:**

6 In accordance with state law, the city of Seattle and the state of  
7 Washington have separately certified to the county assessor the city and  
8 state 2000 property tax levy for collection in 2001. The remaining taxing  
9 districts in the county certified to the county council the levy amounts  
10 desired to be imposed this year for collection in 2001.

11 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:**

12 SECTION 1. The county assessor of King County has certified to the  
13 metropolitan King County council that the assessed valuation of the County of King as  
14 finally equalized amounts to \$188,420,103,797 and as adjusted for senior citizens  
15 exemptions provided for in RCW 84.36.381 and for omitted assessments in accordance  
16 with RCW 84.40.080 is \$187,181,000,747.

17 SECTION 2. Ordinance 14019, Section 3, is hereby amended to read as follows:






