10 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:


11 SECTION 1. The collective bargaining agreement negotiated between King





1 MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

2 BETWEEN

3 INTERNATIONAL FEDERATION OF PROFESSIONAL AND

4 TECHNICAL ENGINEERS, LOCAL 17-Graphic Design

5 AND KING COUNTY

6 FOR 12/15/2000-6/14/2001

7 This Memorandum of Agreement between IFPTE Local 17, and King County operates to extend the  
8 provisions of the current collective bargaining agreement between the parties for six calendar months,  
9 subject to ratification by the King County Council and the Union membership, with the following  
10 modifications:

11 Amends Article 23: Duration, as follows:


12 Section 1. Duration. This Agreement shall become effective December 15, 2000, and shall  
13 remain in effect through June 14, 2001.

14 Amends Addendum A, as follows:


15 Recognition shall be extended to employees within the following job classification: Photo
