1 MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT 2 **BETWEEN** 3 INTERNATIONAL FEDERATION OF PROFESSIONAL AND 4 TECHNICAL ENGINEERS, LOCAL 17-Graphic Design 5 AND KING COUNTY 6 FOR 12/15/2000-6/14/2001 This Memorandum of Agreement between IFPTE Local 17, and King County operates to extend the 7 8 provisions of the current collective bargaining agreement between the parties for six calendar months, subject to ratification by the King County Council and the Union membership, with the following 9 modifications: 10 11 Amends Article 23: Duration, as follows: 12 Section 1. Duration.
