Proposed No. 2001-0169.1 Sullivan **Sponsors** 1 AN ORDINANCE relating to appointments to the housing 2 authority in compliance with chapter 35.82 RCW; and 3 amending Ordinance 12155, Sections 1 and 2, and K.C.C. 4 2.88.015. 5 6 PREAMBLE: 7 For the purposes of providing for more resident involvement, and to 8 increase resident participation and awareness in creating and maintaining 9 a positive living environment, and to comply with the federal and 10 Washington state definitions of who may serve in the position of resident 11 commissioner on the board for public housing. 12 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY: 13 SECTION 1. Ordinance 12155, Sections 1 and 2, and K.C.C. 2.88.015 are each 14 hereby amended to read as follows: 15 Appointments. A. At least one person appointed to the board of commissioners 16 of the King County ((H))housing ((A))authority ((of the County of King)) shall be a

- 17 ((current resident of public housing owned or managed by the)) person who is directly
 18 assisted by the public housing authority.
 - B. No person shall be appointed to the board for more than two successive terms.
- Filling the unexpired portion of a term counts toward the two-term limit.
