1	AN ORDINANCE establishing the 2001 work plan for the
2	regional policy committee of the King County council.

5	PREAMBLE:
6	The regional policy committee of the King County council is established
7	by the King County Charter and directed to develop, recommend and
8	review regional policies and plans for consideration by the metropolitan
9	county council. This ordinance describes the 2001 work plan for the
10	regional policy committee.
11	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
12	SECTION 1. The work plan for the regional policy committee for 2001 shall
13	address countywide policies, plans or topics listed in Attachment A to this ordinance.
14	SECTION 2. In addition to the items listed in section 1 of this ordinance, the
15	work plan shall include countywide policies or plans that respond to current or emergent
16	concerns, that are of regional interest and that relate to multiple jurisdictions. The
