1	AN ORDINANCE relating to the transfer of a portion of
2	Highline Water District to King County Water District No.
3	49 for the purpose of correcting a service boundary
·4	discrepancy between the two districts.
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7 .	STATEMENT OF FACTS:
8	1. A notice of intention proposing the transfer of a portion of Highline
9	Water district to King County Water district No. 49 for the purpose of
10	correcting a service boundary discrepancy between the two district was
11	filed with the county council on April 26, 2001.
12	2. King County Water District No. 49 has found the petition for transfer to
13	be sufficient and has concurred with the proposed transfer in Resolution
14	No. 00-1168, passed on January 26, 2000.
15	3. Highline Water District has found the petition for transfer to be
16	sufficient and has concurred with the proposed transfer in Resolution 00-5-
17	1D passed on May 1, 2001.

18	4. King County Water District No. 49 issued a Determination of
19	Nonsignificance on the proposed transfer dated October 18, 2000.
20	5. The Utilities Technical Review Committee recommended county
21	council approval of the proposed transfer on May 9, 2001.
22	6. The county council held a public hearing on May 21, 2001 and has
23	considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040(3).
24	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
25	SECTION 1. Findings. The county council finds that:
26	A. The proposed action is in compliance with the county's comprehensive plan;
27	B. The proposed action is in compliance with basinwide water or sewage plans;
28	or both; as approved by the state department of ecology and the state department of social
29	and health services; and
30	C. The proposed action is in compliance with the policies expressed in the
31	county's plan for water or sewage facilities, or both.
32	SECTION 2. After consideration of the criteria listed in RCW 57.02.040(3), the
33	transfer to the King County Water District No. 49 from Highline Water District of the
34	area described in Attachment A to this ordinance is consistent with those criteria and is
35	approved. Pursuant to RCW 57.02.045, this approval is final unless review is taken by
36	the King County boundary review board under RCW chapter 36.93.
37	SECTION 3. King County Water District No. 49 is the appropriate entity to serve
38	the area proposed to be transferred.

SECTION 4. Completion of this transfer does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications or actions necessary to provide service to this transferred area."

NOTICE OF INTENTION FOR TRANSFER OF A PORTION OF HIGHLINE WATER DISTRICT TO KING COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 49

Proposed Transfer Area

Legal Description:

That portion of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 30, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M. in King County, Washington.

Beginning at the centerline intersection of 13th Ave SW and SW 174th St; thence Northwesterly along the centerline of SW 174th Street, 69 feet to the true point of beginning; thence South 9 degrees, 59 minutes, 31 seconds West, 132.66 feet; thence South 64 degrees, 00 minutes, 00 seconds West, 97.82 feet; thence South 73 degrees, 00 minutes, 00 seconds West, 539.96 feet; thence North 9 degrees, 32 minutes, 20 seconds West, 158.80 feet; thence North 33 degrees, 00 minutes, 00 seconds East 40.72 feet; thence North 9 degrees, 35 minutes, 20 seconds West, 30 feet to the centerline of SW 174th Street; thence Easterly along the centerline of SW 174th Street, 657 feet more or less to the point of beginning.
