certain hours on certain streets, is amended to add the following roadway:

NE 178th Street, on the north and south sides, between 90th Avenue NE and 92nd


Avenue NE from 7:30 to 2:00 p.m.—school days only.

15 installed by the proper authority.





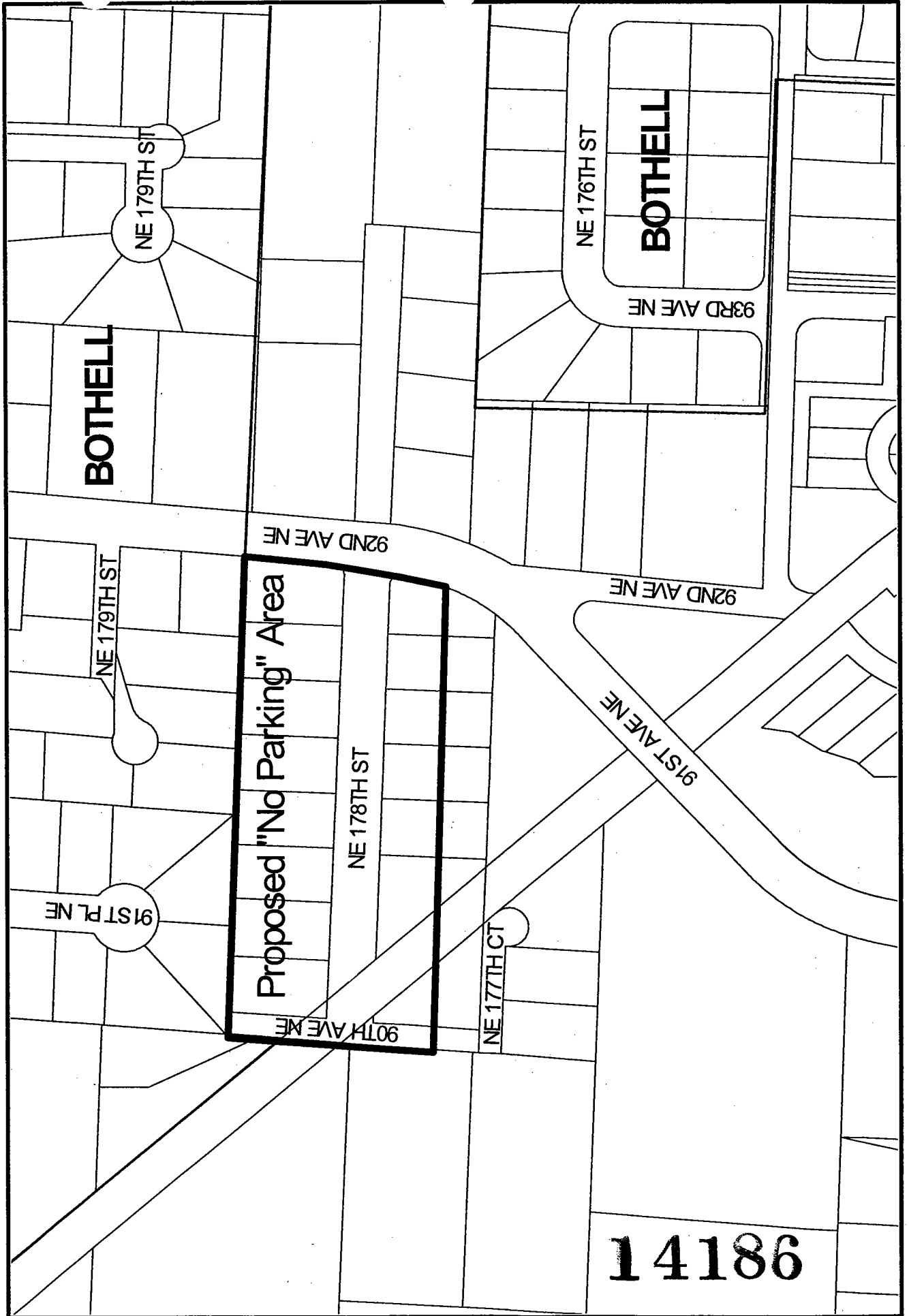
