This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the September 13, 2001, report and recommendation of the hearing 13 14 examiner, filed with the clerk of the council on September 17, 2001, upon the application 15 of Landmark Development to reclassify certain property described in development and

environmental services file no. L00TY404.

SECTION 2. The recommendation of the hearing examiner to reclassify the subject property from NB to R-18 is hereby adopted, subject to conditions. Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the land use services division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
