1 AN ORDINANCE relating to boating regulations;
2 prohibiting the use or operation of internal combustion
3 engines on Lake Alice; and adding a new section to
4 K.C.C. chapter 12.44.

7 **PREAMBLE:**

8 This ordinance, prohibiting the use of internal combustion engines on Lake
9 Alice, is consistent with previous ordinances adopting similar restrictions on
10 other lakes within King County. These ordinances are passed with the intent to
11 ensure the safe use and the preservation of these resources.

12 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:**

13 **SECTION 1.** There is hereby added to K.C.C. chapter 12.44 a new section to

14 read as follows:

15 **Lake Alice restriction.**

16 A. It is unlawful to use or operate any internal combustion engine on Lake
17 Alice, defined as all the water of Lake Alice lying within Section 27, Township 24N,

18 Range 7E; provided, that nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent any public
19 official or construction company from performing their authorized duties.

20 B. The department of transportation shall have the responsibility of posting and
21 maintaining appropriate signs.


