1 AN ORDINANCE relating to labor policy, amending the
2 time for the annual labor summit; and amending Ordinance
3 13000, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 3.16.060.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. Ordinance 13000, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 3.16.060 are
8 each hereby amended to read as follows:

9 **Annual labor summit.** The chair of the King County council shall annually
10 convene a summit between the county's elected officials and the local labor leadership
11 and the leadership of all collective bargaining units representing the county's work force.
12 Such a labor summit shall take place between January 1 and ~~((May))~~ June 1 of each given
13 year. The intent of convening an annual labor summit shall be to: increase
14 communication between King County elected officials and the leadership and
15 membership of local labor organizations and of all the county's collective bargaining
16 units, to identify issues and problems of mutual concern, to identify solutions to problems
17 affecting the memberships of the county's collective bargaining units, to delineate ways

18 in which the county's elected officials may more closely and effectively work with the
19 county's collective bargaining units and local labor organizations to attain mutual goals
20 and to foster a spirit of cooperation in working to serve the public.

21 Meeting minutes at the summit shall be recorded and adopted by the King County
22 council at a subsequent regular meeting of the council.


