1 AN ORDINANCE approving the Dockton Water
2 Association Water System Plan.

5 PREAMBLE:

6 K.C.C. chapter 13.24 requires approval of comprehensive plans for water utilities
7 as a prerequisite for granting right-of-way franchises and approval of right-of-way
8 construction permits.

9 The Dockton Water Association currently provides water service to
10 approximately eight hundred people living on the southern end of Maury Island. The
11 population served in twenty years could increase by about fifty percent because of
12 development and assumption of several smaller systems.

13 The association's water sources include two spring sources and a well. All the
14 water sources have certificated water rights. The existing water demand is approximately
15 fifty-nine thousand gallons per day. This quantity may remain relatively constant even
16 with increasing numbers of customers because of improvements in metering and
17 reductions in system leakage.

18 The plan contains a capital improvement program valued at approximately
19 \$390,000 over the next six years with another \$1,700,000 to be spent during buildout of
20 the system. The planned improvements include enhancements to the existing water
21 supply systems, improved water treatment, repair and modification of reservoirs, and
22 transmission and distribution system improvements.

23 In reviewing and approving the Dockton Water Association Water System Plan,
24 the Metropolitan King County Council strongly encourages the Dockton Water
25 Association to conduct a risk assessment of undersized pipes and associated fire flow
26 issues.

27 The King County utilities technical review committee reviewed and conditionally
28 approved the plan on July 10, 2002. The conditions of approval, technical changes to the
29 plan, are reflected in the plan version attached to this ordinance. The utilities technical
30 review committee recommends that the council approve the plan.

31 A determination of nonsignificance for the plan was issued on July 24, 2002, in
32 accordance with the state Environmental Policy Act. The association has adopted the
33 plan and the state department of health has approved it.

34 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

35 SECTION 1. The Dockton Water Association Water System Plan, Attachment A

36 to this ordinance, is hereby approved without conditions.






