1	AN ORDINANCE authorizing the vacation of a portion of
2	SE Diamond Drive File V-2452 Petitioner(s): Washington
3	National Golf Club LLC.

6	1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of that portion of SE
. 7	Diamond Drive hereinafter described.
8	2. The vacation request is part of the Diamond Ridge Estates Division 2
9	plat alteration application L01ALT02.
10	3. Utility companies serving the area were not notified because the
11	Diamond Ridge Estates Division 2 plat had not been developed prior to
12	the road vacation petition submittal date.
13	4. The department of transportation records indicates that King County
14	has not been maintaining SE Diamond Drive. The records indicate that no
15	public funds have been expended for its acquisition.
16	5. The department of transportation considers the subject portion of the
17	right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and believes the

18	public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax
19	rolls.
20	6. The right-of-way is classified as "D-Class" and, in accordance with
21	K.C.C. 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is for the
22	administrative cost of the vacation. King County is in receipt of \$200
23	from the petitioner.
24	Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was
25	held by the office of the hearing examiner on the 1st day of October, 2002.
26	In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation,
27	the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of
28	King County to grant said petition.
29	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
30	SECTION 1. The council, on the 28th day of October, 2002, hereby vacates and
31	abandons that portion of SE Diamond Drive as conveyed to King County by the
32	recording of Plat Diamond Ridge Estates, Division 2 recorded in Volume 196 of Plats,
33	Pages 1 through 16, records of King County, Washington as described below:
34	That portion of the SE Diamond Drive right-of-way, as
35	shown on the plat of Diamond Ridge Estates, Division 2, as
36	recorded in volume 196, pages 1 through 16, Auditors file
37	No. 20001010000450, of the records of King County,
38	Washington, from the west right-of-way line of 148th
39	Avenue SE to a point on the centerline of said SE Diamond
40	Drive, said point being 140.00 feet NE of the intersection

DEPARTMENT'S REPORT:

The Department of Transportation's written report to the King County Hearing Examiner for Item No. V-2452 was received by the Examiner on September 17, 2002.

PUBLIC HEARING:

After reviewing the Department of Transportation's Report and examining available information on file with the petition, the Examiner conducted a public hearing on the subject as follows:

The hearing on Item No. V-2452 was opened by the Examiner at 1:30 p.m., October 1, 2002, in the Eighth Floor Conference Room of the Union Bank of California Building, 900 – 4th Avenue, Seattle, WA 98104, and closed at 1:35 p.m. Participants at the public hearing and the exhibits offered and entered are listed in the attached minutes. NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL AND ADDITIONAL ACTION REQUIRED

In order to appeal the recommendation of the Examiner, written notice of appeal must be filed with the Clerk of the King County Council with a fee of \$125.00 (check payable to King County Office of Finance) on or before October 16, 2002. If a notice of appeal is filed, the original and 6 copies of a written appeal statement specifying the basis for the appeal and argument in support of the appeal must be filed with the Clerk of the King County Council on or before October 23, 2002.

Filing requires actual delivery to the Office of the Clerk of the Council, Room 403, King County Courthouse, prior to the close of business (4:30 p.m.) on the date due. Prior mailing is not sufficient if actual receipt by the Clerk does not occur within the applicable time period. The Examiner does not have authority to extend the time period unless the Office of the Clerk is not open on the specified closing date, in which event delivery prior to the close of business on the next business day is sufficient to meet the filing requirement.

If a written notice of appeal and filing fee are not filed within 14 days calendar days of the date of this report, or if a written appeal statement and argument are not filed within 21 calendar days of the date of this report, the Clerk of the Council shall place a proposed ordinance which implements the Examiner's recommended action on the agenda of the next available Council meeting. At that meeting, the Council

may adopt the Examiner's recommendation, may defer action, may refer the matter to a Council committee, or may remand to the Examiner for further hearing or further consideration.

Action of the Council Final. The action of the Council on a recommendation of the Examiner shall be final and conclusive unless within twenty-one (21) days from the date of the action an aggrieved party or person applies for a writ of certiorari from the Superior Court in and for the County of King, State of Washington, for the purpose of review of the action taken.
