9	PREAMBLE:
10	At the June 27, 2003, meeting of the King County District Court
11	elected officials, a vote was taken on the question of whether or not
12	to change the structure of court probation services. This meeting
13	was held in accordance with LARLJ (Local Administrative Rule for
14	Courts of Limited Jurisdiction, King County) 0.3; voting was held in
15	accordance with the mandate of LARLJ 0.4; and a quorum was
16	determined pursuant to LARLJ 0.6. Among the King County
17	District Court elected officials present at the June 27, 2003 meeting,

18	the vote was unanimous in favor of replacing the current probation
19	structure and placing King County District Court Probation services
20	under the judicial function model of Judge managed, supervised
21	Probation.
22	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
23	SECTION 1. Ordinance 4549, Section 3, Ordinance 9282, Section 2, Ordinance
24	14374, Section 2, and K.C.C. 2.68.020 are each hereby repealed.
25	SECTION 2. Existing employees of the division of probation who were hired
26	prior to October 22, 1979, and who remain with the new judicially managed system of
27	supervised probation, and who pursuant to Ordinance 4549 are being provided with
28	employment rights at least equivalent to those which they were accorded under the career

service system as established by Article 5 of the King County Charter, shall continue to

be provided with such employment rights.
