2	approximately 13.59 acres to Soos Creek Water and Sewer
3	District for the purpose of providing sewer service for

7	STATEMENT OF FACTS:
8	1. A notice of intention proposing the addition of approximately 13.59
9	acres to Soos Creek Water and Sewer District for the purpose of
10	providing sewer service for future development was filed with the county
11	council effective December 18, 2003.
12	2. Soos Creek Water and Sewer District has found the petition for
13	transfer to be sufficient and has concurred with the proposed transfer in
14	Resolution No. 2503-S, passed on September 3, 2003.
15	3. Soos Creek Water and Sewer District filed a Determination of
16	Nonsignificance on the proposed annexation dated September 3, 2003.
17	4. The utilities technical review committee recommended county council

18	approval of the proposed annexation.
19	5. The county council held the legally required public and has considered
20	the criteria in RCW 57.02.040.
21	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
22	SECTION 1. The addition of approximately 13.59 acres to Soos Creek Water and
23	Sewer District for the purpose of providing sewer service for future development
24	described in Attachment A to this ordinance is approved. This proposed annexation is
25	consistent with RCW 57.02.040.
26	SECTION 2. Soos Creek Water and Sewer District is the appropriate entity to
27	serve the area proposed to be annexed.
28	SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval

or disapproval of any other permits, certifications or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.

#### ANNEXATION NO. P-361S LEGAL DESCRIPTION

A description of the proposed area to be annexed is as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the north margin of Southeast 290<sup>th</sup> Place (also known as E.H. Evanson Road No. 410) and the West line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 4, Township 21 North, Range 6 East, W.M., in King County, Washington, said point being on the existing corporate boundary of Soos Creek Water and Sewer District;

Thence easterly along the north margin of said road, to the centerline of the Vantage-Covington No. 1, 1964 line (Bonneville Transmission Line Easement), said point being on the existing corporate boundary of Soos Creek Water and Sewer District;


Thence Northeasterly along said centerline the Vantage-Covington No. 1, 1964 line (Bonneville Transmission Line Easement) to the Westerly margin of 216<sup>th</sup> Avenue Southeast, said point being on the existing corporate boundary of Soos Creek Water and Sewer District;

Thence northerly along the Westerly margin of said 216<sup>th</sup> Avenue Southeast to the north line of said Northwest Quarter of Section 4, said point being on the existing corporate boundary of Soos Creek Water and Sewer District;

Thence westerly along the north line of said Northwest Quarter of Section 4 to the Northwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 4;

Thence southerly along the west line of said Northwest Quarter of Section 4 to the Point of Beginning.
