BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 263, Article 5 Section 13, as amended, and K.C.C.

20.24.170 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

Rules and conduct of hearings.

A.1. The examiner shall adopt rules, including any amendments to the rules, for

the conduct of hearings and for any mediation process consistent with this chapter ((

13

~~within ninety days of the effective date of Ordinance 11502. The rules shall be reviewed~~

~~by the council, and remain in effect during this review. Any modifications made by the~~

15

~~council by motion shall be incorporated by the hearing examiner, and shall become~~

~~effective ten days after adoption of the motion)).~~

17 2. The hearing examiner may propose amendments to the rules by filing a draft
18 of the amendments and a draft of a motion approving the amendments in the office of the
19 clerk of the council, for distribution to all councilmembers for review. At the same time
20 as the filing of the draft, the hearing examiner shall also distribute for comment a copy of
21 the proposed amendments to any county department that has appeared before the
22 examiner in the year before the filing of proposed amendments and to any other parties
23 who have requested to be notified of proposed amendments to the rules. Comments to
24 the proposed amendments may be filed with the clerk of the council for distribution to all
25 councilmembers for sixty days after the proposed amendments are distributed for
26 comment. The amendments shall take effect when they have been approved by the
27 council by motion.

28 ((Sueh)) 3. The hearing examiner shall publish the rules ((shall be published))
29 and any amendments to the rules and make them available ((upon request to all interested
30 parties)) to the public in printed and electronic forms and shall post the rules and any
31 amendments to the Internet.

32 B. The examiner shall have the power to issue summons and subpoena to compel
33 the appearance of witnesses and production of documents and materials, to order
34 discovery, to administer oaths((;)) and to preserve order.

35 C. To avoid unnecessary delay and to promote efficiency of the hearing process,
36 the examiner shall limit testimony, including cross examination, to that which is relevant
37 to the matter being heard, in light of adopted county policies and regulations((;)) and shall
38 exclude evidence and cross examination that is irrelevant, cumulative or unduly


39 repetitious. The examiner may establish reasonable time limits for the presentation of
40 direct oral testimony, cross examination and argument.

41 D. Any written submittals will be admitted only when authorized by the examiner
42 under pertinent and promulgated administrative rules.


