1 AN ORDINANCE establishing the designation of stay-out-
2 of-drug-area emphasis areas within King County; and
3 establishing the violation of court ordered conditions
4 related to the stay-out-of-drug-area emphasis areas as a new
5 offense.

8 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

9 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the King County council to establish in King
10 County areas that have been identified by law enforcement through a history of arrests
11 and observation to be locales where illicit drug sales, possession of drugs, pedestrian or
12 vehicular traffic attendant to drug activity, or other activity associated with drug offenses
13 confirms a pattern associated with drug trafficking as designated by state law. The
14 following sections identify those areas of drug trafficking that have been identified as
15 meeting the criteria for being protected against drug trafficking areas.

16 SECTION 2. The following described areas of King County are designated to be
17 stay-out-of-drug areas, which are as emphasis areas where there has been a history of

18 identified illegal drug sales and penalties shall be applied in event of conviction of acts in
19 violation of the Uniform Code for Substance Abuse, within the areas, in accordance with
20 this, to assure elimination of all illegal drug possession, use and sales-related activity
21 within these areas:

22 A. The area of Pacific Highway South between South 116th and 128th Street
23 boundary, Military Road South and South 140th and South 152nd, 42nd South and South
24 139th to South 144th, including the motels and hotels within these areas, and including
25 the area one block to the east and west of Pacific Highway South, Military Road South
26 and 42nd South within the boundaries;

27 B. Des Moines Way South from 96th Avenue South to South 128th Street and a
28 block on either side. Military Road South from Des Moines Way South to South 128th
29 Street and 14th Ave. S. from 96th Avenue S. to the South Park Bridge; and

30 C. The Southwest Roxbury from 4th Avenue SW to 17th Avenue SW and from
31 Roxbury Avenue SW to 107th Avenue SW on 14th Avenue SW and 15th Avenue SW
32 and 16th Avenue SW and 17th Avenue SW.

33 SECTION 3. The presence of any person within a stay-out-of-drug-area
34 emphasis area in violation of court-imposed conditions of release or conditions of
35 suspension or deferral of any sentence shall constitute a separate crime hereby designated
36 a misdemeanor and any such person may be apprehended and arrested without the
37 necessity for any warrant or additional court order. Upon conviction, any person so
38 violating the conditions of release or conditions of suspension or deferral shall be
39 punished by imprisonment in jail for a maximum term fixed by the court of not more than

40 ninety days, or by a fine in an amount set by the court of not more than one thousand
41 dollars, or by both such an imprisonment and fine.

42 SECTION 4. This ordinance expires December 31, 2006.


