7	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
. 8	SECTION 1. Ordinance 13000, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 3.16.060 are
9	each hereby amended to read as follows:
10	Annual labor summit. The chair of the King County council shall annually
11	convene a summit between the county's elected officials and the local labor leadership
12	and the leadership of all collective bargaining units representing the county's work force
13	Such a labor summit shall take place between January 1 and ((June)) July 1 of each given
14	year. The intent of convening an annual labor summit shall be to: increase
15	communication between King County elected officials and the leadership and
16	membership of local labor organizations and of all the county's collective bargaining
17	units((, to)); identify issues and problems of mutual concern((, to)); identify solutions to

problems affecting the memberships of the county's collective bargaining units((,-to));

delineate ways in which the county's elected officials may more closely and effectively

work with the county's collective bargaining units and local labor organizations to attain

mutual goals; and ((to)) foster a spirit of cooperation in working to serve the public.

Meeting minutes at the summit shall be recorded and adopted by the King County
